Haldukhata, Uttarakhand, 20th December 2021: In yet another initiative towards improving supply of electricity for people of Kotdwar, a 33/11 KV GIS Substation was inaugurated today in Haldukhata, Kotdwar as part of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'.

Along with the modernized 33/11 KV GIS Substation, a 20 MVA Gas Insulated Power Station was also dedicated to the people of Kotdwar during the occasion.



The GIS sub-station was inaugurated by Honorable Dr. Harak Singh Rawat, Minister of Energy and Renewable Energy, Uttarakhand Govt. in the presence of Shri Anil Kumar, Managing Director, Uttarakhand Power Corporation Ltd (U.P.C.L). Areas like Motadhak, Mavakot, Durgapuri, Padampur, Ghamadpur, Kalalghati and Haldukhata will be largely benefitted with the installation of GIS sub-station.

In recent past, PFC has commissioned and inaugurated various substations and RT-DAS systems across cities in the country as well as part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, ensuring uninterrupted power supply to remote regions of various states.



Some of the places where the projects have been implemented are Dehradun (Uttarakhand), Solan (H.P), Bhagalpur (Bihar), Dharmanagar(Tripura), Bandipora (J&K), Purnia (Bihar). Further, PFC was recently conferred with the Maharatna status by Government of India giving the company greater operational and financial autonomy.
